### • Director, Career Guidance Center:

The Center started in 1994 at SH College, Thevara, and served as its director till 2009. The center is equipped with a library containing an exclusive collection of career books and periodicals. The Center organized seminars on various topics like Career Prospects in the New Millennium, How to Face an Interview, How to Take Part in a GD, Development of Communication Skills etc. The Center also organized various campus recruitment programs for prestigious multinational and national companies.

### • Director, Campus Ministry:

The Campus Ministry conducts orientation programs for the new comers to help them get acquainted with the campus life. It also organizes prayer meetings for the students. Other activities undertaken by the Campus Ministry are orientation programs for the faculty and non-teaching staff of the college and Life Guidance Programs for the PG students in the college.

### • Assistant Director, Counseling Center:

The center gives direction to the students who face various difficulties in their studies- economic, social, psychological, and familial. As the director, I personally interact with the students and encourage them to seek the help of the counselor specially appointed for the purpose.

### • Director, Jesus Youth:

Jesus Youth organizes regular prayer meetings in the campus. The members of the Movement collect money to give scholarship to the poor students by skipping their mid day meals on all Fridays and by avoiding extravagance and other prodigality.

## • Director, PG Orientation Programs:

Every year a three day workshop is organized for the PG students of the college. They are given talks on topics like value education, career orientation and preparation for a successful family life. The third day is set apart for visiting some pilgrim centers and some social action centers.

## • Assistant Co-Ordinator, Semester Around The World Program:

This is a unique program conducted in S.H. College, Thevara, wherein 50 students from Notre Dame University, Indiana, USA, come to the college and spend a semester here. We teach them Indian Culture, Indian Philosophy, Indian Economic Thought, Indian Art, Indian Political system etc. They attend classes of two months duration and one month is set apart for visiting various places in the country. We conduct exams and marks and grades are given. The Notre Dame University considers this mark as the marks obtained in a semester.

- Organizer, Food for the Poor Program: This is a new initiative started under my leadership. On all Fridays when students come to the college they bring an extra lunch packet and deposit it in a box kept in the college. A volunteer social agency would collect the packet around 10.00 am and distribute them to the street children in the city. As per the schedule prepared by me each Friday is allotted to a department in the college. So, a student has got to bring packets only once in two months.
- Resource Person for Career Guidance Programs in Different Colleges: Conducted one-day career guidance programs in more than 25 colleges inside and outside Kerala. Talks were given on general career trends, how to write a good curriculum vitae, how to face an interview, how to take part in a GD etc.
- Resource Person For The Staff Enrichment Programs For Faculty In Various Colleges:

Conducted Staff Enrichment Programs for the faculty both inside and outside Kerala State. The main topics discussed were management principles for tactful administration, value education themes, practical tips for easy administration etc.
